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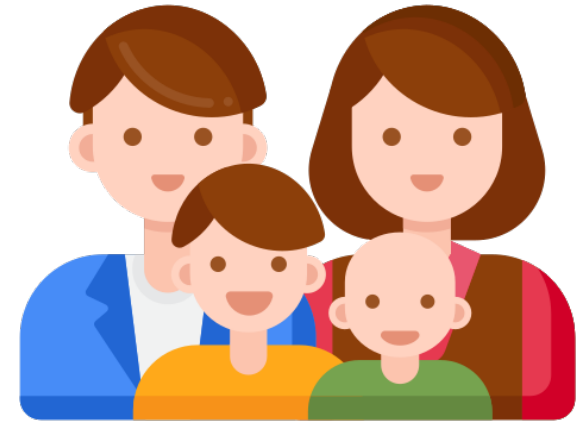
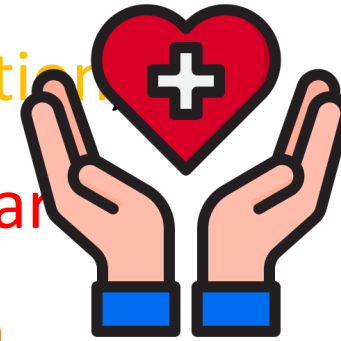
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Children's rights include the right to health, education, family life, play and recreation, an adequate standard of living and to be protected from abuse and harm



# Not everyone knows this, but children's rights also include:



Children's rights, similarly to human rights, are divided according to categories into rights:



-personal, enabling the child's development. These are: the right to life, the right to identity, the right to development, the right to be brought up in a family, the right to express one's own views, the right to information;

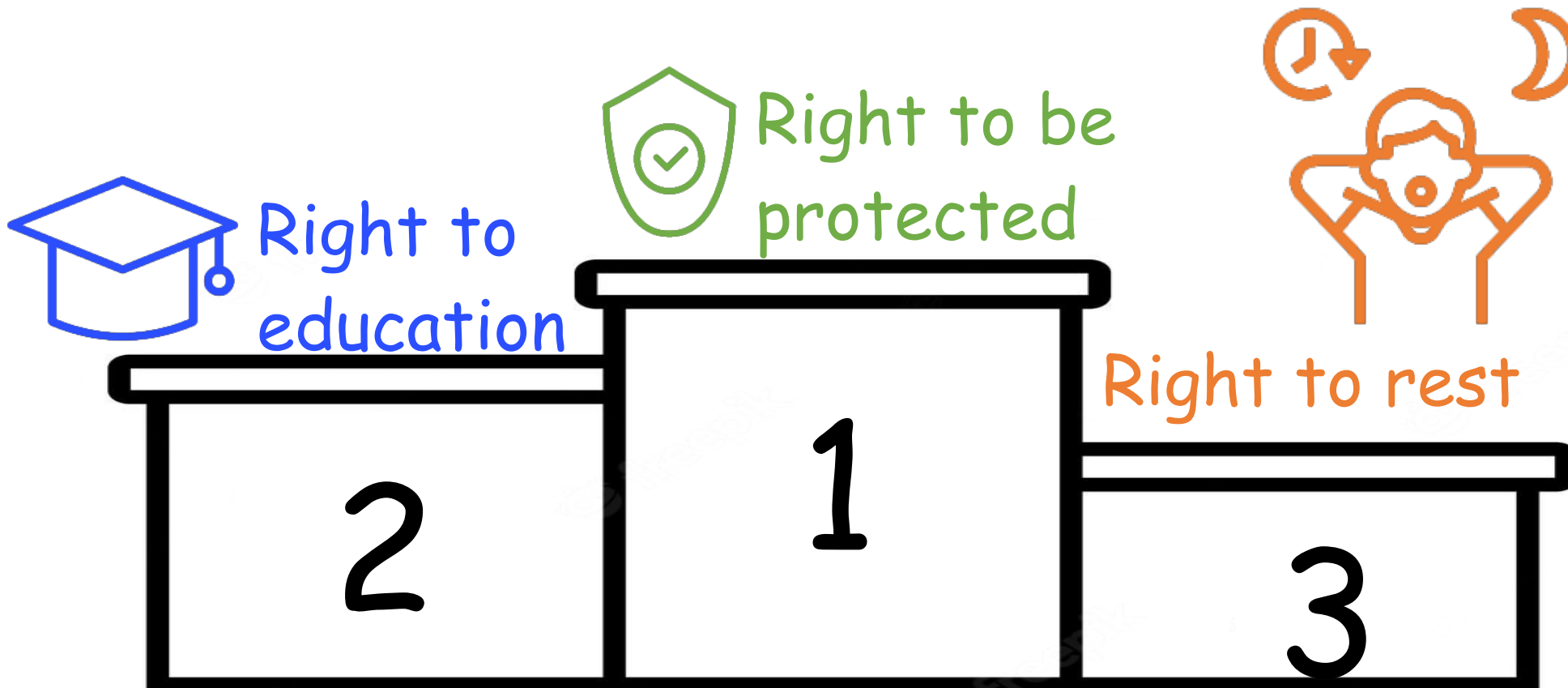
-political or public, thanks to which the child expresses his views and participates in the life of his group, community, country. These are the rights: the right to express one's own views, the right to participate in associations;

-social, which are the duties of the state and adults to create appropriate conditions for the mental and physical development of the child. These are: the right to decent living conditions and an adequate standard of living, the right to health care, the right to rest;

-economic, enabling the child to prepare for material independence from others. The most important is the right to education; in addition, protection of the right to work undertaken.

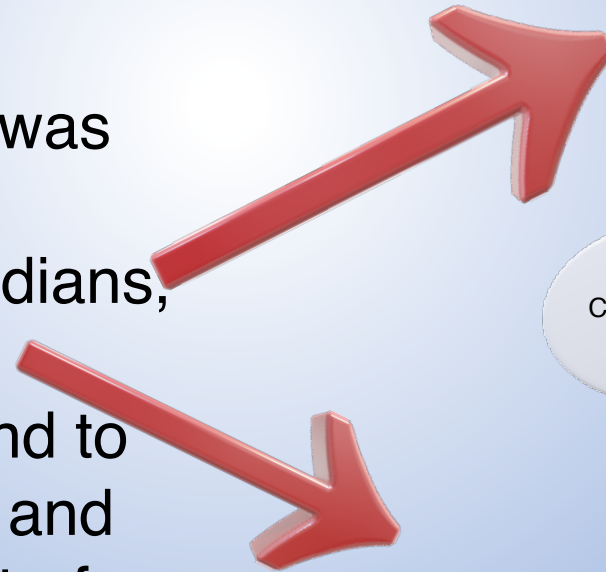
# Duties of the child written in the law

The fact that the duties of a child are a contractual thing, depending on how this issue is resolved by his parents, the law also introduces regulations in this matter.

In Art. 91 of the Family and Guardianship Code, an obligation was imposed on the child:

- listening to your parents and guardians,
- help in the house.

Help from the child must correspond to his physical and spiritual strength, and the fulfillment of duties must not interfere with his upbringing and education.

## **Duties that students should have at school:**

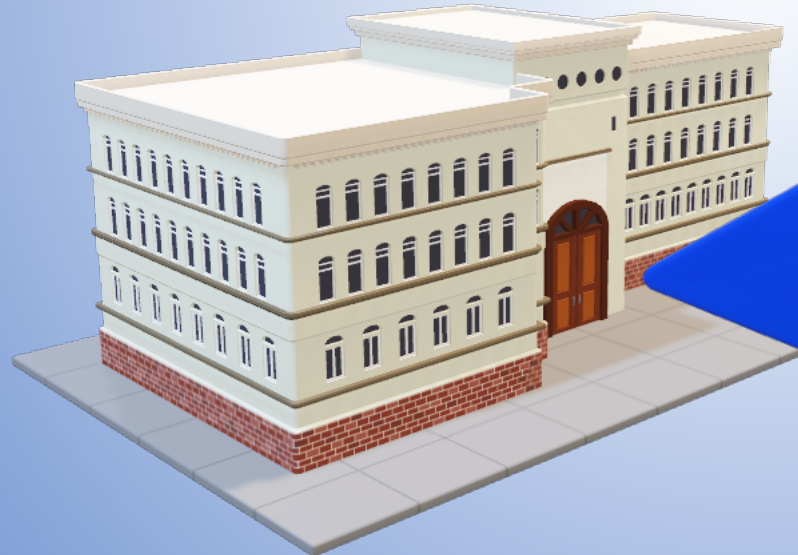
1. Listen to the teachers.
2. Maintain discipline in the class.
3. Come to school on time.
4. Keep the school clean.
5. Be kind to all teachers and students.
6. Be helpful to other students.
7. Move safely on the school halls, gym and other places.
8. Abide by the rules of the school.
9. Complete homework on time.
10. Participate actively in school classes and activities.



# Student's responsibilities at school

The student is also obliged to:

1. comply with the provisions of the School Statute.
2. take care of the school's honor and represent it with dignity.
3. respect the emblem, anthem and flag of the school .
4. show respect to all school staff .
5. have and wear a school ID.
6. systematic and active participation in compulsory and additional educational activities.
